#### Enrolment

112 pupils currently enrolled.

Admission notice is on the school website for 2023. Signs have been placed locally. 18 children on the waiting list for September 23 (15 of whom are confirmed)

The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on (There must be a minimum period of 3 weeks between this date and the Commencement date for accepting applications for admission)

February 1<sup>st</sup> 2023

The date by which applications will be notified of the decision on their application is (this date must be within 3 weeks of the closing date for receipt of application or within 3 weeks of the application date for late applications)

February 21st 2023

The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is

March 1<sup>st</sup> 2023

#### Staffing

This year our school is part of a Supply teaching group in the East Limerick area. This means that there are two permanent teaching posts in the area dedicated to substitution when teachers are on approved leave, ie sick leave, family leave, etc.

So far this year the majority of substitutable days have been covered by a fully qualified teacher with 3 days occurring when no sub was available. When this happens our SET teachers cover the class. This means that SEN pupils miss their time with SET teachers on those days.

All SEN parent teacher meetings were held in person.
