
## Caherelly NS February 2023 NEWSLETTER



### **School Activities**

- Rugby Blitz: In early January, Bruff Rugby Club hosted a blitz for local schools. Our pupils had 6 training sessions in school before Christmas with Danny Keogh. Many thanks to Danny for his work with our pupils and for organising the blitz, our pupils really enjoyed the experience.
- Art Blast: Classes from 3rd to 6th are rolling up their sleeves and getting to experience new art techniques with our artist in residence, Yvonne Edmonds this spring. ### News from our Classrooms - (a little sample of what's going on in our classrooms)

Junior Infants are learning their sounds and are very busy blending. They are fantastic at reading their decodable readers.

Senior Infants are learning a lot of Irish and are practising it every day in the classroom. They are talking about the weather, days of the week and things in the classroom.

First and second class have worked very hard on Procedural writing. The children planned, created multiple drafts and finally wrote their procedure for display. They also orally presented them to fifth and sixth class. They learned lots about how Chinese New Year is celebrated and about Chinese culture in general. They have created some beautiful Chinese dragon art and are learning about colour, tone and texture through collage!

3rd and 4th class have been invited to participate in indoor hurling in Caherconlish. Training has been very competitive and great fun during lunchtimes. Well done to the boys team on last week's performance. The date for the girls games is yet to be announced.

Pupils from 3rd - 6th are continuing their creative process with our Artist in Residence, Yvonne Edmonds . They have already created great pieces of batique. Thanks to parents for sending in supplies.

5th Class are working on their typing skills and narrative writing based on their class novel Wonder. They have all enjoyed creating their own characters to input into the story

5th & 6th classes made St Brigid's crosses to celebrate St Brigid's day. It's tricky but nice to keep the tradition alive.
